

## Honey Bee Disease – Practical Open Day

We are holding a Honey Bee Disease practical open day on Saturday the 28<sup>th</sup> April 2018, at the Jubilee hall in Newton on the Moor, between 10:00 and 12:00

Please bring along a sample of 20-30 bees from one of your colonies and we will take you through looking at them for some of the common pests and diseases in our area.

### The Sample of Bees

- Feel free to take the sample from a colony that is perhaps building up slowly, to see if we can find out why.
- If you like, you can bring up to three sample from different hives
- Collect the sample from the top of the brood nest frames in a small ziplock plastic bag
- Make sure you don't get the queen☺
- Please freeze them overnight, so we don't have live bees in the hall!

### Turning up

- It will be very helpful and avoid lots of standing around if you could pick a time between 10:00 & 11:00 to turn up, rather than every one turning up at the same time.
- Please car share as much as you can to cut down on the number of cars in the village.

### Directions

Newton on the Moor is located approximately 15 miles north of Morpeth, just off the A1. Newton on the moor is well sign posted off the A1 from the North and the South.

**Please take extra care when approaching this junction, when joining and leaving the A1, as it is a simple T junction off a dual carriageway**

The Village is 200m from the A1.  
The Jubilee hall is on the main road running through the village, opposite an old style red telephone box.
